Assistant Coaching Officer Role:

Liaise and agree areas of priority and responsibility with the Kent Coaching Officer and KCTTA.

Improve networking between coaches and coaching activities in clubs and leagues in the non-London/Metropolitan areas of Kent.

Make occasional visits to coaches and coaching activities in the non-London areas of Kent to update on and discuss coaching issues, and possibly lead on or contribute to coaching sessions.

Update Kent lists of qualified and/or active coaches and coaching sessions/activities. Publicise coach lists and coaching activities and update on coaching issues and information to the non-London areas of the county.

Assist with the preparation of Kent junior and cadet ranking lists.

Bring any other/new coaching proposals that may arise to KCTTA for approval.

COMMITTEE CORNER

The third MC meeting was held on 13th March in Maidstone.

The main points of interest from the last meeting on 13th March were;

- Kent League Tables We want to have all teams post their results on the website. We
 can then produced very up to date league tables. With your help we can help you
 have better information.
- Kent League Matches postponements seem to be getting worse and causes
 considerable problems and additional costs. It is very prevalent in division 1 and
 affects maintaining interest in and gaining new players to participate in the Kent
 League. It has disappointed David for some time now and we are receiving complaints
 from affected clubs. If we can make any sensible change to aid reversing the number

- of postponements then tell us, it is though for the Leagues to ensure they meet their fixture commitments without inconvenience to their opponents.
- Kent Ranking List In response to a suggestion we are commencing to produce a
 Junior Ranking List. This will help you and us see how the youngsters are progressing
 and aid team selection and even help identify the number of teams we can sustain.
- Development Officer The role remains vacant for helping promote TT across the County. A volunteer is sought. Do contact us if you are or know someone who would be interested in doing this worthy role.
- Finances The Treasurer reports we look to be on course for a balanced budget, breaking about even on income versus outgoings.
- The ETTA It is noted they have made new appointments. Generally they are non TT specific people but ones with a record of bringing other sports into line with Sport England criteria and raising performance.
- Kent Closed It was reaffirmed entry into the tournament is for players eligible to play for Kent in the County Championships. This means as one of the important conditions they regularly participate in one of our Affiliated Leagues.
